Services include - Psychiatric Evaluations & Medication Management, Individual Screenings & Counseling, Community-based Rehabilitation Services for Adults, Skills Training for Children, Case Management, and Telemedicine & Telehealth.

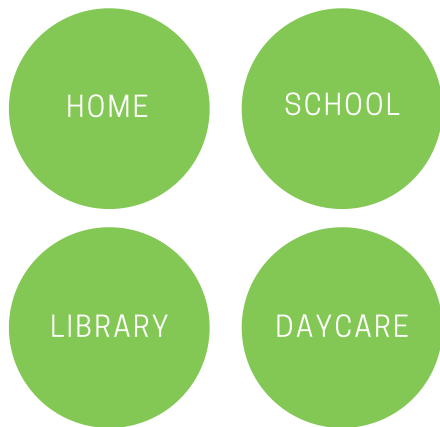
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MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

Services are provided by a staff consisting of Board Certified Psychiatrists, Advanced Psychiatric Nurse Practitioners, Licensed Clinical Social Workers, Licensed Professional Counselors, and other Qualified Mental Health Professionals.

Services may take place in one of our clinics or in a community setting, depending on the service being provided, and as appropriate to the needs of the child, adult, or family. Potential settings include:



At Child & Family Guidance Center, **no one will be turned away based on their inability to pay.**

PAYMENT OPTIONS

We accept Medicaid, CHIP, Medicare, and most private insurance plans. We work with individuals at all levels of financial need to identify the best option to cover cost of services.

PSYCHIATRIC EVALUATION & MEDICATION MANAGEMENT

Client services begin with complete psychiatric evaluations. Clients are then provided with a diagnosis and provided with treatment options for comprehensive care. Individuals in need of medication are also provided with appropriate prescriptions and medication management services.

INDIVIDUALIZED SCREENINGS & COUNSELING

Individualized screenings are clinical assessments that include substance abuse assessments, medication assessments, and financial eligibility screening to improve access to affordable mental health services for low-income families. Based on the screening, individuals are provided with a service plan.

Outpatient mental health counseling, including individual therapy, family, and group therapy are provided by licensed mental health professionals.

COMMUNITY-BASED REHAB SERVICES FOR ADULTS

A Child & Family team member meets seriously mentally ill adults where they are to assist with building life skills to ensure they can be successful in school, the work-place, social situations, at home and in all other areas of the individual's life.

SKILLS TRAINING FOR CHILDREN

A Child & Family team member meets seriously emotionally disturbed children and their families where they are to assist with building life skills to ensure they can be successful in school, the community, social situations, at home and in all other areas of the individual's life.

CASE MANAGEMENT

Ensure each client and family (when applicable) receive necessary psychiatric, social, vocational, educational, and other support essential for achieving stability. Each client is assigned to a specific type of case management, based upon an assessment of the client's needs.

COMPREHENSIVE TELEMEDICINE & TELEHEALTH

Child & Family team members meet clients where they are to facilitate remote delivery of physician services. This enables clients to receive quality care, a proper diagnosis, and continued treatment in areas lacking mental healthcare professionals.



ADDITIONAL CHILD & FAMILY PROGRAMS

Assertive Community Treatment (ACT)

Community-based mental health care for adults living with a serious mental illness that interferes with their ability to live in the community, attend appointments, and manage mental health symptoms.

Outpatient Competency Restoration (OCR)

Community-based services for adults who have been diagnosed with a chronic, persistent mental illness and deemed incompetent to stand trial.

Safety Net (Drug Prevention & Intervention)

School & Community-based, youth program serving Dallas, Collin, & Denton counties via drug and alcohol education, goal-setting, stress management, communication skills, and anger management.

Youth Empowerment Services (YES)

Family-centered, community-based, program designed to help children and youth, ages 3 to 18, who are at risk of out-of-home placement due to serious mental, emotional, and behavioral difficulties.
